

R.V. CAMPING

- **R.V. Camping Season** May 1 – October 15 Weekend.
- **Family & Senior Camping** Only.
- **Rate** includes 2 Guests; site includes camping and swimming during water park season.
- **Extra Persons** are an additional fee of \$6, per person, per day. All family members must be registered at check-in.
- **One Unit per R.V. Site** – 6-person limit; R.V. must accommodate each guest on reservation.
- **Tents** are not permitted on R.V. sites; no tent camping available.
- **Visitors** or add-ons after initial registration pay Campsite Visitor fee.
- **Check-In Time:** 1pm–7pm (Late check-in available with reservation, please inquire before arrival.)
- **Check- Out Time:** 12:30 pm (Guests may pull camper off site to Parking Lot #5 to stay & swim until 7 p.m.)

CAMPING INFO & RULES

- **ALCOHOL AND DRUGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN PARK.** We reserve the right to inspect coolers.
- **BICYCLES** allowed, use at own risk. Parents must accompany very young children.
- **CANCELLATION POLICY** Campers must call to cancel a reservation 2 days prior to arrival, 1-week for Holiday weekends. Cancellations made before this time will be charged a \$10 fee. Reservations made online are charged an additional, non-refundable \$5 convenience fee. Cancellations/No-shows after minimum requirement will be charged one night's stay, excluding any discounts.
- **CONCESSION STAND/ICE** available in summer, weather pending/limited hours.
- **FAMILY & SENIOR CAMPING ONLY**, strictly enforced.
- **FIREWOOD** is self-serve. Cost is \$14 a rack load or \$5 a bundle. Please pay at beach office during hours of operation.
- **MATS/RUGS/CARPET PIECES** are not allowed on campsite; this helps maintain sites for each camper.
- **OFFICE HOURS** (In-Season, Memorial Day Wknd.-Labor Day): Sun-Th 11am - 7pm; Fri & Sat-11am - 8pm
- **OFFICE HOURS** (Off-Season): M-Th 11am - 6pm; Fri 11am - 8pm; Sat 11am - 2pm & Closed Sunday
- **PARENTS** must accompany children to water park area and are responsible for their actions. Children must return to campground after water park closes.
- **PETS are allowed to accompany R.V. campers ONLY;** must be kept on a short leash in **designated areas.** They are not permitted around swimming/paddleboat lakes. Keep pets out of building and please, **clean up after them** while walking & at campsite. Limit 2 dogs per camper; no overly large or aggressive breeds permitted. **Pets must be kept quiet and may not be left unattended outside of RV.** Pet release form must be signed upon check-in.
- **QUIET HOURS** are 10pm - 9am.
- **RESERVATION MINIMUM** 2-day reservation required for weekends (in-season); 3 days for holidays. Reservations highly recommended.
- **SITE** may be chosen by guest, but management reserves the right to change site if necessary. Campground has chipped-and-sealed roads with grassy areas; includes picnic table and open fire ring.
- **SWIMMING** is available during designated park hours only; lifeguard must be on duty. Please check dates/ hours of water park operation.
- **TENTS are not permitted on R.V. sites; NO tent camping available.** Sorry, no exceptions.

CAMPING INFO & RULES CONTINUED

- **TRASH** should be placed in dumpsters; please do not leave on picnic tables or at campsite.
- **TREES/BRANCHES** may not be cut or mutilated.
- **VEHICLE PARKING** at campsite is available if space allows. Extra parking is available in nearby parking lots.
- **VISITORS** of camper pay daily fee during water park season & must exit park by 10pm. See prices in "Nightly Rates".
- **WIFI** is available & free of charge.

Enjoy a scenic stroll through the woods on our walking path. It's a great area to strap on your sneakers and run, jog or walk the dog!

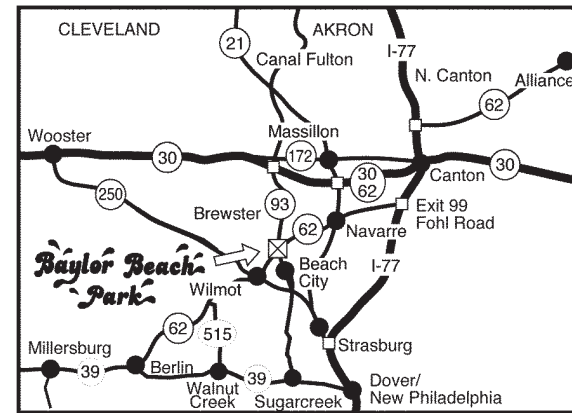

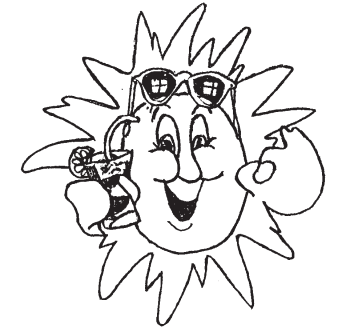

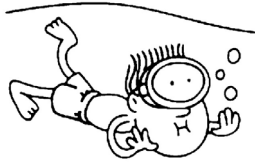

WATER PARK INFO & RULES

- **ALCOHOL AND DRUGS** are not allowed anywhere in the park. We reserve the right to inspect coolers.
- **BALLS** may not be thrown in water unless approved by lifeguard.
- **CANOPIES** are allowed but must not obstruct the lifeguard's view.
- **CHARCOAL FIRED, TABLE TOP GRILLS** are not permitted on picnic tables. Charcoal grills are located around the park for guest use.
- **COOLERS** may be brought into park and are randomly inspected; no alcohol allowed.
- **DISORDERLY CONDUCT/DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY/TRESPASSING** violators will be prosecuted.
- **FIREWORKS, FIREARMS, BOWS & ARROWS** are not permitted.
- **FLOATS & SAND TOYS** are permitted; no oars or motorized floats.
- **FOOD AND DRINKS** (non-alcoholic beverages only) may be brought into the park.

WATER PARK INFO & RULES CONTINUED

- **GLASS BOTTLES** are not allowed.
- **LIFEGUARDS** must be on duty for guests to swim; swimming is available during designated hours only. Only lifeguards may swim during safety breaks.
- **LIFEJACKETS** are encouraged, but not required, and are available at no charge at stations around swimming lake.
- **LOST AND FOUND** Baylor Beach Park is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal property. Please, do not wear valuable jewelry, glasses, etc. when swimming. Please, do not take valuables, such as cell phones & keys onto water boat rides. "Lost and Found" available at Beachhouse.
- **MANAGEMENT** of Baylor Beach Park are always available at park office, please report any incidents that need attention. Management has the right to refuse admission or remove persons from park.
- **METAL DETECTORS** are not permitted.
- **MUSIC** may not be loud or contain obscenities.
- **NON-SWIMMERS** are not allowed in the "Danger Deep Water" roped off area, on diving/dock/boards or on the blue tube slide.
- **P.A. ANNOUNCEMENTS** are strictly for Park & Emergency use.
- **PARENTS must accompany children to water park area.** Ages 13 & under (and non-swimmers) must be accompanied by an adult. Do not leave small children or non-swimmers unattended. Parents are responsible for their children's actions and whereabouts.
- **PETS** are not allowed to accompany swimmers, picnickers. Pets also may not be left in guest's vehicles. Please leave your pets at home. (Pets restricted to R.V. sites only.)
- **PROFANITIES AND OBSCENITIES** will not be tolerated. Anything displaying either of these, i.e. clothing/tattoos, is not permitted; reason for removal from park.
- **PROPER SWIMWEAR ATTIRE required.** No thongs or G-strings. No regular (non-swimwear) shorts, cut-offs, overly baggy or see-thru T-shirts allowed. All swimming attire must be above the knee for safety purposes. Swimwear must not have rivets if using the blue tube slide. No nude or partially nude sunbathing.
- **RAINCHECKS/REFUNDS** will not be issued.
- **RE -ENTRY** is available for Swimmers & Picnickers leaving and returning to park the same day. Guests must get a wristband from the Park Office BEFORE leaving. Guests not wearing a wristband must pay daily admission to re-enter.
- **SAFETY BREAKS** are taken regularly.
- **SMOKING** permitted in designated areas only.
- **SPEED LIMIT** 10 mph.
- **SWIM DIAPERS** required for infants, toddlers, or anyone who requires diapers on a daily basis.
- **TRUNK CHECKS** are randomly performed.
- **WEATHER** In case of inclement weather, seek shelter in Shower House.



HELP US KEEP EVERYONE SAFE!

LIFE JACKETS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED!

They are available free of charge and are located at designated locations around the swimming lake.



Please keep in mind that parents or guardians are responsible for watching the children that they bring. Our lifeguards are here to help prevent accidents by enforcing the rules but you are responsible for watching and keeping track of your own children. If the children in your care are not competent, independent swimmers, you must stay within arm's reach of them at all times.

If your child appears to be struggling and an adult is not within arm's reach, a lifeguard may require your child to wear a life jacket.

If a lifeguard finds it necessary to go into the water for your child, you will be required to fill out a form provided to you, by the office.

If young children are continually left unattended, you may be asked to leave.

Diving Board Area is reserved for STRONG SWIMMERS ONLY. Swimmer must use appropriate swim strokes while in roped off area.

HELP US KEEP OUR WATER CLEAN!

- Please take your toddlers to the restroom frequently.
- Do not let a child who is ill swim in the water; especially if they are vomiting or have diarrhea.
- Plastic diaper covers are Health Department recommended and are available at the Beach House for a minimal cost.
- Please discourage your children from digesting the swimming water by not letting them put it in their mouths.
- PLEASE WATCH YOUR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES!
